On a daily basis local women would be hired for “piece” work, anything from organizing the merchandise in the trading post to preparing meals and even sorting furs. Become a part of our little community here at the Fort and discover the past through participating in the daily routine at Fort Gibraltar.

Before you get introduced to the working life of the Fort you need to have a good meal. One of our guides will lead your group to *La Maison du Bourgeois* for some traditional fare. Once you have finished eating you will be presented with a sash. What respectable voyageur would be seen without one? Now you are ready to get started!

Begin your fur trade experience with one of our tour guides who will explain what Fort Gibraltar is all about. Then your group will be divided into four and presented to one of our experts who will explain his or her special contribution to the business of the fur trade and then guests will get the opportunity to try out the exciting tasks!
